Greetings from Bangkok, Thailand! I hope this newsletter finds you all very well. I hope you had a great holiday season! May the New Year bring you joy, love, peace, and plenty of success. I am grateful for every one of you for being a part of my life and I thank God for you. Last year was a great year in my life. God has been good to me and he has blessed me abundantly. It has been about two months since I arrived in Bangkok, Thailand. I have already settled in at my apartment and have set up my workspace at the Ramkhamhaeng Christian Center (in Bangkok). This is the same place where I, myself, became a Christian 14 years ago. The Center is affiliated with the Watcharapon Church of Christ. It offers free English classes for students and everyone who is interested in studying English and the Bible. From time to time we will have a group called "Let's Start Talking" and many from the US come here to teach English through the Bible. The location of the center has changed and there are many new faces, but the atmosphere is still the same and centered on our shared faith.

#### My Works

I have been working on curriculum for our children's ministry for three separate age groups. This curriculum will be published and used at the Watcharapon Church of Christ and other churches around Thailand. The curriculum will also be translated into the Laos language and will be used by churches at Laos. Later on I plan to develop classes for teachers' workshops.

I am also working on translating children's songs so that singing can be used along with the lesson plans. I am grateful to a brother who is a song leader and will be helping me put notes along with the songs into a book (there are no children's songs book available yet). At the same time I will be helping with women seminars, teaching women classes, and one on one Bible studies along with other outreach activities.

Please continue to pray for the missions work in Thailand and the work that I am involved in.
