Update on mission work in Thailand

Dear All,

I pray and hope that this message finds you all doing well. I would like to tell you all about several great items of news; we have a new sister in Christ; her name is Winnie, who was baptized last Friday, June 5, 2009. Winnie has been coming to the Ramkhamhaeng Christian Center for about three months and wanted to study more about Christianity. Winnie had a background of being Catholic and Buddhist. Several people had studied and talked with her and after three months, she knew that she needed to be baptized and we praise God for her decision.

We have also a new brother in Christ; his name is Eke, who was baptized last Sunday, June 7, 2009. Eke has been coming to worship with us every Sunday at the Watcharapon church of Christ for over a year. Eke cannot walk and talk well; he was in a car accident about two years ago, since then, he is in a wheel chair. I'm grateful for being part of the witnesses at his baptism; it was amazing and brought tears to many people's eyes. Three men had to help Eke to be able to get under the water.

The last news to tell you is that we're going to plant a new congregation at my hometown, Prachinburi. I'm thankful that it is happening sooner than I thought so that many people would hear about the Good News including my family. I'm thankful for Niwat (58-year-old) and Suchin Sakulnakorn (55-years-old). This Thai couple has a desire to have a new church planting at their hometown. Suchin has just graduated from Sunset International Bible Institute this week; one of this school's branches is located at the Watcharapon church of Christ. This couple wants to give their house for being used for a place of worship. This Saturday, we will go to Prachinburi and prepare and fix the place since the couple has not lived at their house for the last several years. And then the following Saturday, we will go there again to pass fliers and invite people to come to worship with us on Sunday, 21, 2009, we will begin worship at 4 p.m. I plan to travel to Prachinburi and help with teaching once a month. Also some Christians at the Watcharapon church of Christ will take turns to go preach and teach.

Please pray for those new Christians with their beginning walk with God and for the new congregation at Prachinburi. Please pray for our work here at the Watcharapon church of Christ and Ramkhamhaeng Christian Center; we work as a team; we have 12 full-time ministers, and we call our team "Tai 4 the Savior." The next several months, from June through August, we are going to be very busy with two English camps, one in June 25-27, 2009 at Loei (located in the North- East of Thailand) and the other in July 17-19, 2008 at Cha-Am, Petchaburi (located in Central of Thailand).

Next week we will have a group of four Let's Start Talking workers from the Southwestern State Oklahoma University, Oklahoma, coming to work with us at the Ramkhamhaeng Christian Center for six weeks. We have been working to find 60 students for them for one-on-one Bible studies. Please pray that many people's hearts would be open to the Gospel through all the work above. And please also pray for us.

Thank you all for supporting me and the ministry in Thailand along with your prayers and words of encouragement. May God richly bless you all as you serve and shine for Him. May the glory be to our Heavenly Father.
